- 4. Each student is responsible for keeping the form after it is completed by their supervisor and for submitting it on time.

NOTE: During the Covid-19 pandemic, if an EdF student is not comfortable in volunteering/working in an in-person setting, the EdF program will waive their volunteer experience hours. It is fully their choice to volunteer/work during the pandemic. If an EdF student should need more experience with elementary kids in a group setting in order to apply to a teaching licensure program after they graduate, they may volunteer at a later time.
